1. **ELIGIBILITY:** All members in good standing of the Henry Clay Philatelic Society as well as all others who wish to exhibit their own material. Material must be the personal property of the exhibitor.
2. **ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:** Entries will be accepted in order of receipt of the entry forms. All fees and instructions must be enclosed with the entry form. Please use a separate form for each exhibit. Entry forms may be duplicated as needed.
3. **DEADLINE:** Entries will be accepted through **March 24** so long as frames are available. Entry forms received after all frame space is taken or after March 24 will be returned.
4. **FEES:** Regular - \$ 6.00 per frame ; Youth (18 and under), First frame of one exhibit is free, \$2.00 per frame for additional frames or entries.
5. **FRAMES:** Frames will hold up to sixteen (16) 8.5 x 11 inch pages.
6. **EXHIBIT LIMITATIONS:** Exhibitors **are limited to two (2) exhibits**. Exhibits may consist of one (1) to no more than ten (10) frames.
7. **CLASSES OF EXHIBITS:**
  - a. **One-frame:** One frame -- May be topical, general or youth.
  - b. **General:** Exhibit containing stamps, covers and philatelic material related to postal history or country.
  - c. **Topical:** Topical exhibit containing stamps, covers and philatelic material related to one subject.
  - d. **Youth/Junior (for exhibitors 18 years of age or younger):** May be any of the aforementioned types.
8. **AWARDS:**

General Awards:  
Best of Show – Best Exhibit of Show  
Grand Reserve – Runner up for Best of Show  
Gold, Silver or Bronze – As warranted, at the discretion of the judges  
Youth / Junior Award – Best of Class  
One Frame – Best of Class

Special Awards:  
HCPS Member Award – Best exhibit by a member of HCPS

9. INSURANCE: We carry show insurance. Exhibitors desiring extra insurance must make their own arrangements. All reasonable care will be taken to provide security, including a security guard on duty during the hours the exhibit is closed. The Henry Clay Philatelic Society, the Springs Inn, nor any of their several members or employees shall be liable for damage to, or loss of, an exhibit or material.
10. JUDGING: Judging will be on an open basis. Judges' decisions will be final. Judging will be done by an accredited APS judge on Saturday, March 31, 2007.
11. DELIVERY AND DEADLINES OF EXHIBITS:
  - a. Persons bringing their own exhibits should bring them to the Springs Inn between 8:00 and 9:00 A.M. on Saturday, March 31, 2007.
  - b. Persons mailing exhibits should send them to Mike Strother at the remittance address listed above. They should be mailed so that they arrive no later than Thursday, March 29, 2007.
12. REMOVAL OF EXHIBIT: Exhibits may **not** be removed earlier than the close of the show, 4:00 P.M., Sunday, April 1, 2007.
13. RETURN OF EXHIBITS: Exhibits not picked up will be returned by USPS Priority Mail, \$100.00 insurance, unless other instructions are given. Exhibits to be returned by mail must be accompanied by sufficient funds to cover the cost of return mailing, including any additional services (express, insurance, certified and/or registration). Return postage may be paid by check or by U.S. postage stamps sufficient to cover the total cost of return postage.
